Virtual and Online Policy

Overview

The purpose of the FC Durham Academy Virtual & Online Policy is to ensure the safe and positive environment during all academy online practices, webinars, initiatives and events by providing expectations and general guidelines. It is expected that all members follow these policies and provide an environment while online which all individuals involved are treated with respect and equality.

Policy

- All participants are dressed appropriately, and in FCD attire when possible
- FCD player code of conduct, zero tolerance policy and coach code of conduct and ethics to protect children must be followed during online/virtual activities.
 This includes, but not limited to no offensive, inappropriate or distracting behaviour and/or language.
- All members are still expected to behave in a respectful way that is in line with academy values.
- Remember anything on your screen (or in your webcam view) is visible to everyone. We recommend that members use the mute function and disable video where and when they deem it appropriate
- All online/virtual engagement and participation is optional
- Filming or screen shots during online/virtual sessions are prohibited for privacy of those involved
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in discipline action
- Participants are to put player's full name in so they can be identified
